AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 2 Statutes, further providing for safety zones.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 2505 of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
- 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 7 § 2505. Safety zones.
- 8 (a) General rule. -- Except as otherwise provided in this
- 9 title, it is unlawful for any person, other than the lawful
- 10 occupant, while hunting game or wildlife, taking furbearers of
- 11 any kind, or pursuing any other privilege granted by this title,
- 12 to hunt for, take, trap, pursue, disturb or otherwise chase any
- 13 game or wildlife or to discharge, for any reason, any firearm,
- 14 arrow or other deadly weapon within or through a safety zone, or
- 15 to shoot at any game or wildlife while it is within the safety
- 16 zone without the specific advance permission of the lawful
- 17 occupant thereof.
- 18 (b) Penalty.--A violation of this section is a summary

- 1 offense of the fourth degree.
- 2 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "safety
- 3 zone" means the area within 150 yards, 50 yards for archers in
- 4 <u>urban and suburban areas,</u> around and that area which is below
- 5 the highest point of any occupied dwelling house, residence, or
- 6 other building or camp occupied by human beings, or any barn,
- 7 stable, or other building used in connection therewith or any
- 8 attached or detached playground of any school, nursery school or
- 9 day-care center.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
