MCDADE EXPRESSWAY. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. (A) The portion of U.S. Route 220 from the intersection of S.R.44 to the Halls exit in Lycoming County is designated and shall be known as the Lycoming County Veterans' 10 Memorial Highway. 11 Section 2. (B) The Department of Transportation shall erect 12 and maintain appropriate signs identifying the above portion of 13 road as the Lycoming County Veterans' Memorial Highway. 14 SECTION 2. (A) THAT PORTION OF STATE ROUTE 307 WITHIN THE 15 CITY OF SCRANTON, LACKAWANNA COUNTY, SHALL HEREAFTER BE KNOWN AS
