AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the furnishing of drug-
- 3 free urine for the purpose of evading drug tests.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 7509. Furnishing drug-free urine.
- 9 (a) Unlawful sale or attempt. -- A person commits a
- 10 misdemeanor of the third degree if he offers for sale, sells,
- 11 causes to be sold or gives drug-free urine for the purpose of or
- 12 which is WITH THE INTENT OR KNOWLEDGE THAT THE URINE WILL BE
- 13 <u>used for evading or causing deceitful results in a test for the</u>
- 14 presence of drugs.
- 15 (b) Use or attempt. -- A person commits a misdemeanor of the

- 1 third degree if he uses or attempts to use drug-free urine as
- 2 provided in subsection (a) for the purpose of evading or causing
- 3 <u>deceitful results in a test for the presence of drugs.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
