AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for stopping at posted cattle crossings. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 3710 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 3710. Stopping at intersection or crossing to prevent obstruction.
(a) Intersections, crosswalks, railroad crossings.--No driver shall enter an intersection or a crosswalk or drive onto any railroad grade crossing unless there is sufficient space on the other side of the intersection, crosswalk or railroad grade crossing to accommodate the vehicle operated without obstructing the passage of other vehicles, pedestrians or railroad trains notwithstanding any traffic-control signal indication to proceed.
(b) Cattle crossings. - -No driver shall enter a posted cattle
crossing when animals are present in or passing through the
crossing. The department shall promulgate regulations relating
to the proper size and placement of any cattle crossing signs. A
violation of this subsection is a summary offense punishable by
a fine of not less than $\$ 50$.
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
