## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, defining the offense of unlawful
- 3 contact or communication with minor; AND PROVIDING FOR SALE
- 4 OR ILLEGAL USE OF CERTAIN SOLVENTS.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 6318. Unlawful contact or communication with minor.
- 10 (a) Offense defined.--A person whether within or without
- 11 this Commonwealth commits a misdemeanor of the first degree if
- 12 he, knowing that he is contacting or communicating with a minor
- 13 within this Commonwealth, intentionally contacts or communicates
- 14 with that minor for the purpose of engaging in any of the
- 15 following:

- 1 (1) Any of the offenses enumerated in Chapter 31
- 2 <u>(relating to sexual offenses).</u>
- 3 (2) Open lewdness as defined in section 5901 (relating
- 4 to open lewdness).
- 5 (3) Prostitution as defined in section 5902 (relating to
- 6 prostitution and related offenses).
- 7 (4) Obscene and other sexual materials and performances
- 8 <u>as defined in section 5903 (relating to obscene and other</u>
- 9 <u>sexual materials and performances</u>).
- 10 (5) Sexual abuse of children as defined in section 6312
- 11 <u>(relating to sexual abuse of children).</u>
- 12 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 13 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 14 subsection:
- 15 "Contacts or communicates with." Direct or indirect contact
- 16 or communication by any means, method or device, including
- 17 contact or communication in person or through an agent or
- 18 agency, through any print medium, the mails, a common carrier or
- 19 communication common carrier, any electronic communication
- 20 <u>system and any telecommunications, wire, computer or radio</u>
- 21 <u>communications device or system.</u>
- 22 "Minor." An individual under 18 years of age.
- 23 SECTION 2. SECTION 7303(F) OF TITLE 18 IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 24 § 7303. SALE OR ILLEGAL USE OF CERTAIN SOLVENTS.
- 25 \* \* \*
- 26 (F) DEFINITION.--AS USED IN THIS SECTION THE PHRASE "ANY
- 27 SUBSTANCE CONTAINING A SOLVENT HAVING THE PROPERTY OF RELEASING
- 28 TOXIC VAPORS OR FUMES" SHALL MEAN ANY SUBSTANCE CONTAINING ONE
- 29 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING CHEMICAL COMPOUNDS: ACETONE, ACETATE,
- 30 BENZENE, BUTYL ALCOHOL, ETHYL ALCOHOL, ETHYLENE DICHLORIDE,

- 1 FREON, ISOPROPYL ALCOHOL, METHYL ALCOHOL, METHYL ETHYL KETONE,
- 2 PENTACHLOROPHENOL, PETROLEUM ETHER, OR TOLUENE.
- 3 Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . This act shall take effect immediately. <----
