## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for aid payments to recipients of general assistance
- 2 and aid to families with dependent children who have resided
- in this Commonwealth for less than 12 months.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Aid payment.
- 7 Notwithstanding the maximum aid payments as determined by the
- 8 Department of Public Welfare, recipients of general assistance
- 9 and aid to families with dependent children who have resided in
- 10 this Commonwealth for less than twelve months shall be paid an
- 11 amount calculated in accordance with Department of Public
- 12 Welfare standards, but not to exceed the maximum aid payment
- 13 that would have been received from the recipient's state of
- 14 prior residence, unless that amount exceeds the maximum payment

- 1 level available to recipients in this Commonwealth. When the
- 2 maximum aid payment from a recipient's state of prior residence
- 3 exceeds that amount which would otherwise be available in this
- 4 Commonwealth, the recipient shall receive an amount not to
- 5 exceed the amount available in this Commonwealth.
- 6 Section 2. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
