## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the practice
- of plea bargaining in cases where a firearms offense is
- 4 charged.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 8703. Plea bargaining prohibited for firearms offenses.
- 10 (a) General rule.--In the case of a firearms offense, a
- 11 court may not accept a plea of quilty to a lesser offense or a
- 12 plea of quilty to only one or some of multiple offenses charged
- 13 <u>in return for a lighter sentence than the sentence to be imposed</u>
- 14 for the more serious charge or charges.
- 15 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 16 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 17 <u>subsection:</u>
- 18 <u>"Firearm." As defined in 18 Pa.C.S. § 6102 (relating to</u>

- 1 <u>definitions</u>).
- 2 <u>"Firearms offense."</u>
- 3 (1) Any crime during the commission of which the
- 4 <u>defendant visibly possessed a firearm.</u>
- 5 (2) An offense under 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 Subch. A
- 6 (relating to Uniform Firearms Act).
- 7 Section 2. The addition of 42 Pa.C.S. § 8703 shall apply to
- 8 criminal proceedings commenced on or after the effective date of
- 9 this act.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
