- 1 Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled
- 2 "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth,
- 3 sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising,
- 4 consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto,"
- 5 providing for the abolition of jury commissioners.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 401 of the act of August 9, 1955
- 9 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, is amended by
- 10 adding a subsection to read:
- 11 Section 401. Enumeration of Elected Officers.--* * *
- 12 (d) The office of jury commissioner may be abolished at the
- 13 option of each county by a majority vote of the county
- 14 commissioners.
- 15 Section 2. If abolished by the county commissioners, the
- 16 office of jury commissioner shall expire at the completion of
- 17 the current jury commissioners' terms of office.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
