## AN ACT

1 Designating April 28 of each year as "Workers' Memorial Day." The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 2 3 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Designation of "Workers' Memorial Day." 4 (a) General rule.--April 28 of each year is designated as 5 б "Workers' Memorial Day" in Pennsylvania, and the Governor is 7 authorized and directed to issue a proclamation each year 8 calling on the citizens of this Commonwealth to: 9 (1)Pay tribute to the memory of those courageous and 10 dedicated members of Pennsylvania's labor force who have died as a result of accidents in the workplace. 11 Honor those workers who have been injured or 12 (2) disabled in workplace accidents. 13 14 (3) Recognize the integrity of Pennsylvania's work force and its achievements on behalf of the economic growth of our
Commonwealth.

3 (4) Call for vigilance and increased safety in the4 workplace.

5 (b) Restrictions.--

6 (1) No costs may be incurred with regard to the 7 observance of Workers' Memorial Day by the Commonwealth, a 8 political subdivision or an agency or instrumentality of 9 either.

10 (2) Workers' Memorial Day shall be regarded as a secular 11 or business day. The observance of this day may not be the 12 subject of a collective bargaining agreement to which the 13 Commonwealth, a political subdivision or an agency or 14 instrumentality of either is a party.

15 Section 2. Effective date.

16 This act shall take effect immediately.
