7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 5511.2. Leaving an unattended animal in motor vehicle.</u>
10	(a) General ruleA person driving or in charge of a motor
11	vehicle may not permit an animal to remain unattended in the
12	vehicle when the motor vehicle is out of the person's sight and
13	under circumstances which endanger the health, safety or welfare
14	of the animal.
15	(b) ApplicabilityThis section shall apply to the highways
16	and trafficways of this Commonwealth and, for the purposes of
17	this section only, the term "trafficways" shall include, but not
18	be limited to, parking lots.

- (c) Penalty.--A violation of this section constitutes a 1
- 2 <u>summary offense.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
