AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for speed timing devices.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 3368(c)(2) of Title 75 of the
6	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 3368. Speed timing devices.

9	(c) Mechanical, electrical and electronic devices
10	authorized
11	* * *
12	(2) [Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (3),
13	electronic] <u>Electronic</u> devices such as radio-microwave
14	devices (commonly referred to as electronic speed meters or
15	radar) may be used [only by members of the Pennsylvania State
16	Police] by any police officer. No police officer, other than
17	<u>a member of the Pennsylvania State Police, shall be permitted</u>

1	to use an electronic device until he has successfully
2	completed a training course in the use of such devices
3	conducted by the Pennsylvania State Police.

5	Section 2. The training course described in 75 Pa.C.S. §
6	3368(c)(2) shall commence within one year of the effective date
7	of this act.
8	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
