32 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

1 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1301.11(f) of the act of April 9, 1929 2 3 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, added December 12, 4 1994 (P.L.1015, No.138), is amended to read: 5 Section 1301.11. Report of Property Subject to Custody and Control of the Commonwealth under this Article .--* * * 6 (f) Subsequent to the filing of the reports required by this 7 section, the State Treasurer shall compile a list of the 8 abandoned and unclaimed property contained in the reports. The 9 10 listing shall contain [only] the cash value of the abandoned and 11 unclaimed properties and the names and last known addresses, if any, of the owners listed in the reports. The listing shall not 12 13 be available to any person for examination, inspection or 14 copying prior to twenty-four (24) months after the reports have 15 been filed with or payment or delivery of the property has been 16 made to the State Treasurer. After the twenty-four-month period provided for in this section, the State Treasurer shall make the 17 18 listing available for examination, inspection or copying at fees to be determined by the State Treasurer. 19

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Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
