1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for improper exhibition of cigarette vending machines.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 6306.2. Cigarette vending machine exhibition.
9	(a) Offense definedA retailer or vending machine operator
10	is guilty of a summary offense if the retailer or vending
11	machine operator displays or places, or permits the display or
12	placement of, a cigarette vending machine in a business,
13	commercial establishment or public thoroughfare, in such a
14	manner that a minor under 18 years of age has access to the
15	machine.
16	(b) PenaltyA retailer or vending machine operator who
17	violates this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
18	pay a fine of not less than \$25 for a first offense and not less

1 than \$100 for a subsequent offense.

2	(c) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
3	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
4	subsection:
5	"Cigarette vending machine." As defined in section 202-A of
6	the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal
7	<u>Code.</u>
8	"Retailer." As defined in section 202-A of the act of April
9	9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code.
10	"Vending machine operator." As defined in section 202-A of
11	the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal
12	<u>Code.</u>
13	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
