## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for prohibited parking in specified places.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 3353(a)(2) of Title 75 of the
7	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 3353. Prohibitions in specified places.
9	(a) General ruleExcept when necessary to avoid conflict
10	with other traffic or to protect the safety of any person or
11	vehicle or in compliance with law or the directions of a police
12	officer or official traffic-control device, no person shall:
13	* * *
14	(2) Stand or park a vehicle:
15	(i) In front of a public or private driveway <u>unless</u>
16	the person is the owner or lessee of the garage, parking
17	facility or other structure served by the driveway.
18	(ii) Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.

(iii) Within 20 feet of a crosswalk at an
 intersection.

3 (iv) Within 30 feet upon the approach to any
4 flashing signal, stop sign, yield sign or traffic-control
5 signal located at the site of a roadway.

6 (v) Within 20 feet of the driveway entrance to any 7 fire station or, when properly sign posted, on the side 8 of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station 9 within 75 feet of the entrance.

10 (vi) Where the vehicle would prevent the free11 movement of a streetcar.

12 (vii) On a limited access highway unless authorized13 by official traffic-control devices.

14 (viii) At any place where official signs prohibit15 standing.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
