## AN ACT

Repealing the act of May 10, 1913 (P.L.199, No.138), entitled 2 "An act authorizing and empowering the county commissioners 3 and the county solicitor, and the chief clerk of said commissioners, of each county, to organize themselves into a 5 State Association, for the purpose of holding annual meetings, and providing for the payment of the expenses thereof." 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of May 10, 1913 (P.L.199, No.138), 11 entitled "An act authorizing and empowering the county commissioners and the county solicitor, and the chief clerk of 12 said commissioners, of each county, to organize themselves into 13 14 a State Association, for the purpose of holding annual meetings, and providing for the payment of the expenses thereof," is 15 16 repealed. 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
