8	Section 1. Section 7 of the act of October 5, 1994 (P.L.531,
9	No.78), known as the Human Services Development Fund Act, is

11	Section 7. Allocations.
12	(a) General formula[An] <u>Except as set forth in subsection</u>
13	(a.1), an annual appropriation shall be distributed among the
14	counties as follows:
15	(1) 50% shall be allocated on a per capita basis.
16	(2) 50% shall be allocated on a poverty level basis.

1	(a.1) Cost of living increase. An increase in the State	<
2	allocation up to the rate of the Consumer Price Index of the	
3	previous year shall be distributed as a cost of living	
4	adjustment to all counties. Any remainder of the increase shall	
5	be distributed through the formula set forth in subsection (a).	
6	(A.1) COST-OF-LIVING INCREASEANY INCREASE IN THE STATE	<
7	APPROPRIATION IDENTIFIED AS A COST-OF-LIVING ADJUSTMENT IN A	
8	GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED AS A COST-OF-
