AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 11, 1853 (P.L.165, No.124), entitled
2 "An act authorizing the incorporation of a company to plank
3 the old Lancaster road from Henderson's store to the Spread
4 Eagle, in Delaware county, entitled 'The Radnor plank road
5 company;' relative to certain election districts; to fees for
6 adjusting beam and patent balances, in the city and county of
7 Philadelphia; and relative to the real estate of William
8 Crawford, of Erie county; and to extending the chancery
9 powers of certain courts to Erie county," repealing
10 provisions relating to fees for adjusting scales in
11 Philadelphia.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. Section 9 of the act of March 11, 1853 (P.L.165,
15 No.124), entitled "An act authorizing the incorporation of a
16 company to plank the old Lancaster road from Henderson's store
17 to the Spread Eagle, in Delaware county, entitled 'The Radnor
18 plank road company;' relative to certain election districts; to
19 fees for adjusting beam and patent balances, in the city and
20 county of Philadelphia; and relative to the real estate of
21 William Crawford, of Erie county; and to extending the chancery

1 powers of certain courts to Erie county," is repealed.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
