## AN ACT

- 1 Restricting the location of waste disposal facilities near 2 schools.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Findings.
- 6 The General Assembly, conscious of the public health concerns
- 7 relating to air pollution and other deleterious effects of
- 8 various types of waste disposal, finds that the public health,
- 9 safety and welfare of public school students will be served by
- 10 placing restrictions on issuing permits for the construction and
- 11 operation of waste disposal facilities in close proximity to
- 12 public school buildings.
- 13 Section 2. Definitions.
- 14 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 15 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 16 context clearly indicates otherwise:

- "School entity." A school district, joint school district,
- 2 intermediate unit, area vocational-technical school or charter
- 3 school within this Commonwealth.
- 4 "Waste disposal facility." Any waste incinerator, waste
- 5 treatment facility, solid waste landfill or other operation
- 6 disposing of waste which is required to be permitted by the
- 7 Department of Environmental Protection under the act of January
- 8 8, 1960 (1959 P.L.2119, No.787), known as the Air Pollution
- 9 Control Act, or the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), known
- 10 as the Solid Waste Management Act.
- 11 Section 3. Prohibition of waste disposal facility near school
- 12 entity.
- 13 (a) New construction. -- On and after the effective date of
- 14 this act, the Department of Environmental Protection may not
- 15 issue a permit for any new waste disposal facility within 1,000
- 16 yards of a building which is owned by a school entity.
- 17 (b) Modifications.--Any modification, extension, addition or
- 18 renewals of existing permitted facilities may not bring the
- 19 existing permitted facility closer to a building owned by a
- 20 school entity.
- 21 Section 4. Exceptions.
- 22 This act shall not apply to:
- 23 (1) Waste disposal facilities which received permits
- 24 before the effective date of this act.
- 25 (2) Waste disposal facilities proposed to be utilized by
- 26 municipalities or authorities and which before the effective
- 27 date of this act have entered into contracts for the
- 28 construction of such facilities or completed an escrow or
- 29 permanent bond financing.
- 30 (3) Waste disposal facilities proposed to be utilized by

- 1 more than one municipality, for which municipalities have
- 2 executed intermunicipal pacts and have expended public funds
- 3 prior to the effective date of this act.
- 4 Section 5. Effective date.
- 5 This act shall take effect immediately.
