AN ACT

1 Repealing the Inheritance and Estate Tax Act.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. Repeal.

5 Article XXI of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known
6 as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is repealed.

7 Section 2. Implementation.

8 This act shall apply to the estates of decedents dying on or
9 after January 1, 1999, and to the inter vivos transfers made by
10 such decedents without regard to the date of transfer.

11 Section 3. Effective date.

12 This act shall take effect immediately.
