A RESOLUTION

Declaring May 12 through 18, 1997, as "Senior Center Week in Pennsylvania" in accordance with the nationwide observance of this week.

services and opportunities through senior center programs; and 1 2 WHEREAS, "Senior Center Week" will be celebrated throughout 3 the United States during the week of May 12 through 18, 1997, to increase public awareness of the programs available to senior 4 Americans and to encourage participation in senior center 5 6 programs; therefore be it 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare the week 8 of May 12 through 18, 1997, as "Senior Center Week in Pennsylvania" in order to increase public awareness of the 9 services available to older Americans, to encourage 10 participation by older Americans in senior center programs and 11 12 to recognize and honor the valuable contributions senior 13 Americans continue to make in the lives of members of younger
