- 1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the definition
- 3 of "correction officer."
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The definition of "correction officer" in section
- 7 5102 of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
- 8 amended to read:
- 9 § 5102. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases as used in this part, unless
- 11 a different meaning is plainly required by the context, shall
- 12 have the following meanings:
- 13 * * *
- "Correction officer." Any full-time employee assigned to the
- 15 Department of Corrections [or the Department of Public Welfare]
- 16 whose principal duty is the care, custody and control of inmates
- 17 or direct therapeutic treatment, care, custody and control of
- 18 inmates of a penal or correctional institution[,] or a community

- 1 treatment center[, forensic unit in a State hospital or secure
- 2 unit of a youth development center] operated by the Department
- 3 of Corrections [or by the Department of Public Welfare]. The
- 4 <u>term includes Correctional Therapeutic Workers, Correctional</u>
- 5 Counselors and Psychological Services Aides, Vocational
- 6 Directors, Therapeutic Activity Workers, Caseworkers,
- 7 Psychological Services Associates, Social Workers and
- 8 Psychologists. The term also includes the following employees of
- 9 <u>the Department of Public Welfare:</u>
- 10 (1) At youth development centers: Youth Development
- 11 <u>Counselors I and II.</u>
- 12 (2) At Farview State Hospital: Social Worker I, II and
- 13 <u>III, Caseworker Trainee and Caseworker I, Psychological</u>
- 14 Services Associate I and II, Psychological Services Associate
- Supervisor, Psychologist, X-ray Technician I and II, Dental
- 16 <u>Technician I, Licensed Practical Nurse I and II, Food Service</u>
- 17 <u>Instructor, Food Service Worker I, Cook II, Meat Cutter II,</u>
- 18 Barber I, Psychiatric Nurse Intern, Psychiatric Nurse I, II,
- 19 III and IV, Therapeutic Recreation Service Worker,
- 20 <u>Therapeutic Recreation Service Leader, Therapeutic Recreation</u>
- 21 <u>Service Supervisor, Occupational Therapeutic Worker,</u>
- 22 <u>Vocational Adjustment Service Worker, Vocational Adjustment</u>
- 23 Service Supervisor, Correctional Tradesman Instructor,
- 24 <u>Security Patient Mailman, Recreation Physical Education</u>
- 25 Instructor, Therapeutic Recreation Aide Supervisor,
- Therapeutic Recreation Aide, Arts and Crafts Teacher, Canteen
- 27 Manager, Canteen Clerk, Psychiatric Chaplain, Patient
- 28 Librarian and Pharmacist I and II.
