- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto, " providing partial State reimbursement for mobile classroom facilities. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2574 of the act of March 10, 1949 9

- 11 amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 12 Section 2574. Approved Reimbursable Rental for Leases
- 13 Hereafter Approved and Approved Reimbursable Sinking Fund
- 14 Charges on Indebtedness. -- * * *
- 15 (q) (1) For the lease rental for any mobile classroom and
- subject to the limitations in clause (2), reimbursement shall be 16
- the lesser of: (i) the cost of purchasing the mobile classroom; 17
- or (ii) the product of the rated pupil capacity as determined 18
- by the Department of Education at the time the purchase is 19

- 1 approved and one thousand one hundred dollars (\$1,100).
- 2 (2) The restrictions and limitations which shall apply to
- 3 any reimbursements under this subsection are: (i) the
- 4 <u>utilization of a mobile classroom shall not expand the existing</u>
- 5 student capacity of permanent structures by more than twenty per
- 6 cent (20%); (ii) the mobile classroom shall be used solely for
- 7 <u>a classroom during the period of reimbursement payments; (iii)</u>
- 8 the term of the lease or lease-purchase agreement shall not
- 9 <u>exceed five (5) years; and (iv) reimbursement payments shall be</u>
- 10 made solely for the mobile unit and not for any necessary
- 11 hookups, walkways or other construction or connections necessary
- 12 for the effective functioning of the mobile classroom.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
