15	Section 1. Section 412.1 of the act of June 3, 1937

19	(f) Persons working a half-day shift shall be compensated at
20	one-half the rate of a person working a full day.

22	Section 1208. Meeting of Election Officers on Day of

1 inspectors, clerks of election and machine inspectors, together with the overseers, if any, shall meet in the respective places 2 3 appointed for holding the election in each election district at least thirty minutes before the hour for opening the polls on 4 the day of each primary and election. They shall thereupon, in 5 the presence of each other, take and subscribe in duplicate to 6 the oaths required by this act. Persons working the second half 7 8 of election day shall take and subscribe to the required oath at 9 least thirty minutes before their shift begins.

- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
