6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 5533(b) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 5533. Infancy, insanity or imprisonment.

11	(b) Infancy
12	(1) If an individual entitled to bring a civil action is
13	an unemancipated minor at the time the cause of action
14	accrues, the period of minority shall not be deemed a portion
15	of the time period within which the action must be commenced.
16	Such person shall have the same time for commencing an action
17	after attaining majority as is allowed to others by the
18	provisions of this subchapter. As used in this [subsection]

1 paragraph, the term "minor" shall mean any individual who has not yet attained [the age of 18.] 18 years of age. 2 3 (2) (i) If an individual entitled to bring a civil action arising from childhood sexual abuse is under 18 4 5 years of age at the time the cause of action accrues, the individual shall have a period of 12 years after 6 attaining 18 years of age in which to commence an action 7 for damages. 8 (ii) The filing of a criminal complaint shall not be 9 a prerequisite to the commencement of a civil action 10 11 under this paragraph. (iii) For the purposes of this paragraph, the term 12 13 "childhood sexual abuse" shall include, but not be limited to, the following sexual activities between a 14 minor and an adult, provided that the individual bringing 15 the civil action had engaged in such activities as a 16 result of physical or psychological force or the threat 17 18 of physical or psychological force: (A) sexual intercourse, which includes 19 20 penetration, however slight, of any body part or object into the sex organ of another; 21 22 (B) deviate sexual intercourse, which includes 23 sexual intercourse per os or per anus; and 2.4 (C) indecent contact, which includes any touching of the sexual or other intimate parts of the 25 26 person for the purpose of arousing or gratifying 27 sexual desire in either person. 28 Section 2. The amendment of 42 Pa.C.S. § 5533(b) shall not be applied to revive an action which has been barred by an 29 30 existing statute of limitations on the effective date of this 19970S0447B0470 - 2 -

1 act.

2 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
