AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 9, 1997 (P.L.169, No.14), entitled "An
2 act providing for Statewide nurse aide training programs
3 relating to nursing facilities," further providing for
4 information relating to applicants for enrollment in State-
5 approved nurse aide training programs.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 4(a) of the act of June 9, 1997 (P.L.169,
9 No.14), known as the Nurse Aide Resident Abuse Prevention
10 Training Act, is amended to read:

11 Section 4. Information relating to applicants for enrollment in
12 State-approved nurse aide training programs.

13 (a) Required information.--Individuals applying for
14 enrollment in State-approved nurse aide training programs shall
15 submit with their applications for enrollment the following
16 information obtained within the preceding one-year period:

17 (1) Pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 91 (relating to criminal
18 history record information), a report of criminal history
19 record information from the State Police or a statement from

1 the State Police that their central repository contains no
2 such information relating to that person. The criminal
3 history record information shall be limited to that which is
4 disseminated pursuant to 18 Pa.C.S. § 9121(b)(2) (relating to
5 general regulations).

6 (2) Where the applicant is not a resident of this
7 Commonwealth, the applicant shall be required to submit with
8 his application for enrollment a full set of fingerprints.
9 The department shall forward the fingerprints to the Federal
10 Bureau of Investigation for purposes of conducting a criminal
11 background investigation and receiving a report of Federal
12 criminal history record information [pursuant to the Federal
13 Bureau of Investigation's appropriation under the Departments
14 of State, Justice, and Commerce, the Judiciary, and Related
15 Agencies Appropriation Act, 1973 (Public Law 92-544, 86 Stat.
16 1109)].

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
