AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for bidding requirements.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 751(b) of the act of March 10, 1949
10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
11 amended May 4, 1990 (P.L.164, No.38), is amended to read:
12 Section 751. Work to be Done Under Contract Let on Bids;

13 Exception.--* * *

(b) The board of school directors in any school district may perform any construction, reconstruction, repairs, or work of any nature, where the entire cost or value, including labor and material, is less than [five thousand dollars (\$5000)] twentyfive thousand dollars (\$25,000), by its own maintenance
personnel. The board of school directors in any school district
may authorize the secretary of the board or other executive to
award contracts for construction, reconstruction, repairs, or
work of any nature, where the entire cost or value, including
labor and material, is ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) or less,
without soliciting competitive bids, subject, however, to the
provisions of subsection (a.1).
