## AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for rape.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Section 3121(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
6	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
7	§ 3121. Rape.

9	(b) Additional penaltiesIn addition to the penalty
10	provided for by subsection (a), a person may be sentenced to an
11	additional term not to exceed ten years' confinement and an
12	additional amount not to exceed \$100,000 [where] <u>if any of</u> the
13	following apply:
14	(1) The person engages in sexual intercourse with a
15	complainant and has substantially impaired the complainant's
16	power to appraise or control his or her conduct by administering

or employing, without the knowledge of the complainant, any
 substance for the purpose of preventing resistance through the
 inducement of euphoria, memory loss and any other effect of this
 substance.

5 6 (2) The complainant:

<u>(i) is under 16 years of age; and</u>

7 (ii) becomes pregnant as a result of the sexual
8 intercourse.

9 Section 2. The provisions of 18 Pa.C.S. § 3121(b)(2) shall 10 apply to prosecutions commenced on or after the effective date 11 of this act.

12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
