AN ACT

Amending the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No.205), entitled "An act relating to unfair insurance practices; prohibiting unfair methods of competition and unfair or deceptive acts and practices; and prescribing remedies and penalties," further providing for unfair or deceptive acts or practices.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. Section 5(c)(3) of the act of July 22, 1974 (P.L.589, No. 205), known as the Unfair Insurance Practices Act, is amended to read:

Section 5. Unfair Methods of Competition and Unfair or Deceptive Acts or Practices Defined.--* * *
(c) Nothing in subsection (a) (9) of this section shall apply:

(3) To any policy or bound application of insurance which has been in effect less than sixty days, including any notice of termination period, unless it is a renewal policy. The insured or applicant shall receive written notice of any declination of
