AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, providing for juvenile crime
- 6 programs.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1550. Juvenile Crime Program. -- Beginning with the
- 13 1999-2000 school year and each subsequent year thereafter, the
- 14 Department of Education shall have the power and its duty shall
- 15 be to:
- 16 (1) Develop and provide resource information to educators
- 17 and public and private elementary and secondary schools and
- 18 organizations on juvenile crime.

- 1 (2) Provide for distribution to school entities and public
- 2 and private or nonpublic elementary and secondary schools in
- 3 this Commonwealth materials on juvenile crime. Such materials
- 4 shall include, but need not be limited to, the mechanics of the
- 5 juvenile justice system and the nature of delinquency
- 6 proceedings, the penalties for committing a crime that would be
- 7 graded higher than a misdemeanor if committed by an adult and
- 8 the consequences of committing a crime.
- 9 (3) The Secretary of Education shall prepare and submit an
- 10 <u>annual report to the Governor and the General Assembly outlining</u>
- 11 juvenile crime programs and achievements, highlighting new
- 12 <u>initiatives and recommending future programs</u>.
- 13 (4) The Secretary of Education shall consult at least
- 14 annually with the Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police,
- 15 and other law enforcement personnel which the Secretary of
- 16 Education deems necessary, in order to prepare the materials and
- 17 <u>assess the trends of juvenile crime in this Commonwealth.</u>
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
