## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for vehicle registration; and
- 3 increasing certain penalties.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Sections 1305(a) and 1308(a) of Title 75 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 1305. Application for registration.
- 9 (a) General rule.--Application for the registration of a
- 10 vehicle shall be made to the department upon the appropriate
- 11 form or forms furnished by the department. The application shall
- 12 contain the full name and address of the owner or owners; the
- 13 make, model, year and vehicle identification number of the
- 14 vehicle; the color of the vehicle; the vehicle owner's personal
- 15 information, including date of birth, operator's license number
- 16 <u>and Social Security number;</u> and such other information as the
- 17 department may require. Applicants for registration of a truck,
- 18 truck tractor, trailer or bus shall provide the vehicle's Gross

- 1 Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), or the Gross Combination Weight
- 2 Rating (GCWR), as applicable. If the manufacturer's ratings are
- 3 not available, the applicant shall provide sufficient
- 4 information as to the horsepower, braking capacity and such
- 5 other data as necessary for the department to determine an
- 6 equivalent measure of the vehicle's hauling and stopping
- 7 capability. If the applicant wishes to register a vehicle at a
- 8 registered gross weight less than the gross vehicle weight
- 9 rating, the application shall include information as to weight,
- 10 load and any other such information as the department may
- 11 require. The application shall be accompanied by self-
- 12 certification of financial responsibility and the applicable
- 13 fee.

- 15 § 1308. Issuance of registration card.
- 16 (a) General rule. -- The department, upon registering a
- 17 vehicle, shall issue to the registrant a registration card which
- 18 shall contain the registration number assigned to the vehicle,
- 19 the name and address, the date of birth, Social Security number
- 20 <u>and operator's license number</u> of the registrant and the name of
- 21 the owner, if other than the registrant, a description of the
- 22 vehicle including the vehicle identification number, the
- 23 expiration date, the make, model and color of the vehicle and
- 24 such other information as may be determined by the department.

- 26 Section 2. Section 1331(c), heading amended December 21,
- 27 1998 (P.L. , No.151), is amended to read:
- 28 § 1331. Issuance and reissuance of registration plates.
- 29 \* \* \*
- 30 (c) Temporary registration plates.--The department shall

- 1 provide temporary paper registration plates, with the expiration
- 2 <u>date prominently displayed</u>, for use on vehicles which are to be
- 3 removed from this Commonwealth or for use as necessary pending
- 4 issuance of permanent registration plates.

- 6 Section 3. Section 7121 of Title 75 is amended to read:
- 7 § 7121. False application for certificate of title or
- 8 registration.
- 9 A person is guilty of a [misdemeanor of the first degree]
- 10 <u>felony of the second degree</u> if the person uses a false or
- 11 fictitious name or address or makes a material false statement,
- 12 or fails to disclose a security interest, or conceals any other
- 13 material fact in an application for a certificate of title or
- 14 for registration.
- 15 Section 4. Section 7122 of Title 75, amended December 21,
- 16 1998 (P.L. , No.151), is amended to read:
- 17 § 7122. Altered, forged or counterfeit documents and plates.
- A person is guilty of a [misdemeanor of the first degree]
- 19 <u>felony of the second degree</u> if the person, with fraudulent
- 20 intent:
- 21 (1) alters, forges or counterfeits a certificate of
- title, registration card or plate, inspection certificate or
- 23 proof of financial responsibility;
- 24 (2) alters or forges an assignment of a certificate of
- 25 title, or an assignment or release of a security interest on
- 26 a certificate of title or any other document issued or
- 27 prepared for issue by the department;
- 28 (3) has possession of, sells or attempts to sell, uses
- or displays a certificate of title, registration card or
- 30 plate, driver's license, inspection certificate proof of

- financial responsibility or any other document issued by the
- department, knowing it to have been altered, forged or
- 3 counterfeited;
- 4 (4) obtains or attempts to obtain a certificate of
- 5 inspection without valid proof of financial responsibility;
- 6 or
- 7 (5) provides a certificate of inspection where there is
- 8 no valid proof of financial responsibility.
- 9 Section 5. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
