AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of December 14, 1992 (P.L.835, No.134),
- 2 entitled "An act providing for the establishment,
- organization, operation and termination of fraternal benefit
- 4 societies; imposing additional powers and duties on the
- 5 Insurance Department and on the Insurance Commissioner;
- 6 providing penalties; and making repeals, "further providing
- 7 for licensing of agents.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 609 of the act of December 14, 1992
- 11 (P.L.835, No.134), known as the Fraternal Benefit Societies
- 12 Code, is amended to read:
- 13 Section 609. Licensing of agents.
- 14 (a) General rule. -- Agents of societies shall be licensed in
- 15 accordance with the insurance laws regulating the licensing,
- 16 revocation, suspension or termination of license of resident and
- 17 nonresident agents.
- 18 (b) Exemptions from licensure. -- No examination or license
- 19 shall be required of any regular salaried officer, employee or
- 20 member of a licensed society who devotes substantially all of

- 1 his services to activities other than the solicitation of
- 2 fraternal insurance contracts from the public and who receives
- 3 for the solicitation of such contracts no commission or other
- 4 compensation directly dependent upon the amount of business
- 5 obtained.
- 6 (c) Examination.--
- 7 (1) Any person who in the preceding calendar year has
- 8 solicited and procured life insurance contracts on behalf of
- 9 any society in an amount of insurance in excess of [\$100,000]
- 10 \$200,000 or, in the case of any other kind or kinds of
- insurance which the society might write, on the persons of
- 12 more than 25 individuals and who has received or will receive
- a commission or other compensation therefor shall be required
- 14 to take an examination. No examination shall be required of
- any agent who was in the service of a society on January 28,
- 16 1978.
- 17 (2) At least once every five years the commissioner
- 18 shall review the monetary limit contained in this subsection
- 19 and may, in the commissioner's discretion, adjust the amount.
- 20 Any adjustment to the amount shall be published as a notice
- in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- 22 (d) Limitation.--No society doing business in this
- 23 Commonwealth shall pay any commission or other compensation to
- 24 any person for any services in obtaining in this Commonwealth
- 25 any new contract of life, accident or health insurance, or any
- 26 new annuity contract, except to a licensed fraternal insurance
- 27 agent of that society.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
