AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581),
- 2 entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending
- and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," exempting
- 4 boroughs from certain filing and service fees.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3301 of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965
- 8 P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, amended October 9,
- 9 1967 (P.L.399, No.181) and repealed in part April 28, 1978
- 10 (P.L.202, No.53), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 3301. Prosecution of Ordinance Violators;
- 12 Disposition of Fines, Penalties and Costs. -- Any violation or
- 13 failure to comply with any provision of any borough ordinance
- 14 shall constitute a summary offense and prosecution for every
- 15 such offense shall be according to the practice in the case of
- 16 summary convictions. Whenever any borough enforces an ordinance
- 17 by means of a civil proceeding, that borough shall be exempt

- 1 from the payment of any filing or service fees associated with
- 2 the complaint.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
