AN ACT

- 1 Providing for a nonbinding referendum in the city of the first
- 2 class on the matter of public funding for professional sports
- 3 stadiums.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Philadelphia
- 8 Stadium Site Referendum.
- 9 Section 2. Authorization.
- 10 The County Board of Election in the city of the first class
- 11 shall cause to be printed on the official ballot, at the primary
- 12 or general election occurring at 30 days next following the
- 13 effective date of this act, a nonbinding referendum to determine
- 14 the will of the electorate in the city of the first class with
- 15 respect to public funding of professional sports stadiums.
- 16 Section 3. Form of question.
- 17 The referendum question shall be in substantially the
- 18 following form:

- 1 Do you favor the location of a new baseball stadium in
- 2 the City of Philadelphia at:
- 3 (1) Broad and Spring Garden Streets;
- 4 (2) 30th Street;
- 5 (3) South Philadelphia Sports Complex; or
- 6 (4) Port Richmond?
- 7 Section 4. Conduct of election.
- 8 The referendum required under this act shall be advertised
- 9 and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the act of
- 10 June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania
- 11 Election Code.
- 12 Section 5. Effective date.
- 13 This act shall take effect immediately.
