AN ACT

Amending the act of January 24, 1966 (1965 P.L.1535, No.537), 1 entitled, as amended, "An act providing for the planning and 2 3 regulation of community sewage systems and individual sewage 4 systems; requiring municipalities to submit plans for systems 5 in their jurisdiction; authorizing grants; requiring permits 6 for persons installing such systems; requiring disclosure 7 statements in certain land sale contracts; authorizing the 8 Department of Environmental Resources to adopt and administer 9 rules, regulations, standards and procedures; creating an advisory committee; providing remedies and prescribing 10 penalties," further providing for sewage enforcement officer 11 12 powers.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

14 hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 8 of the act of January 24, 1966 (1965 P.L.1535, No.537), known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read: Section 8. Powers and Duties of Local Agencies.--* * *

1	(e.1) A sewage enforcement officer not employed by the local
2	agency may conduct site evaluations, soil testing or percolation
3	testing to determine site suitability for on-lot sewage disposal
4	systems which are permitable by local agencies and may prepare
5	specifications, drawings and all related documents necessary for
6	or ancillary to the design of on-lot sewage disposal systems
7	which are permitable by local agencies under this act and the
8	regulations adopted by the department.

10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
