## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 5 laws relating thereto," further providing for the resignation 6 of superintendents. 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 11 section to read: Section 1073.1. Resignation of Superintendent. -- (a) A board 12 of school directors which has formally accepted a resignation of 13 14 its district superintendent may not act for a period of one hundred fifty (150) days after the effective date of the 15 16 resignation to elect the same individual, whose resignation it previously accepted, to the position of district superintendent. 17 (b) Upon acceptance of the resignation of the district 18

superintendent, the board shall publicly advertise the vacancy

- 1 and publicly announce that other candidates will be considered
- 2 for the office.
- (c) For the purposes of this section, the term "resignation" 3
- 4 <u>shall mean formal renouncement or relinquishment of an office.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
