- 9 Section 1. Section 111(c) of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- 11 amended December 19, 1990 (P.L.1362, No.211), is amended to

- 13 Section 111. Background Checks of Prospective Employes;
- 14 Conviction of Employes of Certain Offenses. --* * *
- 15 (c) [Where the applicant is not a resident of the
- 16 Commonwealth, administrators] Administrators shall also require

- 1 the applicant to submit with the application for employment a
- 2 report of Federal criminal history record information pursuant
- 3 to the Federal Bureau of Investigation appropriation of Title II
- 4 of Public Law 92-544, 86 Stat. 1115, and the department shall be
- 5 the intermediary for the purposes of this section.
