AN ACT

- 1 Appropriating a portion of any unallocated surplus in the
- 2 General Fund to the Department of Education for the purchase
- 3 of textbooks for public school students.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Appropriation of unexpended and unencumbered
- 7 surplus.
- 8 If the Secretary of the Budget certifies that there is a
- 9 surplus of operating funds for the fiscal year 1999-2000 in the
- 10 General Fund, and if a surplus continues to exist after the
- 11 transfer under section 622 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
- 12 No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, then there is
- 13 hereby appropriated to the Department of Education for the
- 14 fiscal year 2000-2001 a sum of money not to exceed \$35 per pupil
- 15 for all public school pupils enrolled as of May 1, 2000, in the

- 1 public schools to be distributed by the Department of Education
- 2 to the public school districts on a per pupil basis and to be
- 3 used for the purchase of new textbooks. These funds must be
- 4 expended by December 31, 2001.
- 5 Section 2. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect immediately.
