A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of May 9 through 15, 1999, as "Pennsylvania
2 MADD Drunk Driving Awareness Week."

3 WHEREAS, In 1997 more than 16,000 people lost their lives in
4 alcohol-related traffic accidents; and

5 WHEREAS, The economic costs relating to alcohol-related
6 accidents are estimated to be in excess of \$45 billion annually;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, All residents of this Commonwealth should be more
9 aware of the serious peril resulting from drunk driving;
10 therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
12 week of May 9 through 15, 1999, as "Pennsylvania MADD Drunk
