A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the week of May 22 through 28, 1999, as "National Safe Boating Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Boating has become the Commonwealth's premier
- 4 recreational activity as more Pennsylvanians than ever head to
- 5 the beautiful waterways of this Commonwealth for recreation and
- 6 relaxation; and
- 7 WHEREAS, All boaters need to start the season with the basic
- 8 knowledge and skills required to ensure their own safety and the
- 9 safety of all other boaters and other persons who utilize the
- 10 waterways for recreation; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The theme of "National Safe Boating Week" recognizes
- 12 that hundreds of lives are needlessly lost and would be saved by

- 1 the simple step of wearing life jackets, which is the law and
- 2 just plain common sense; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all
- 4 Pennsylvanians to observe the week of May 22 through 28, 1999,
- 5 as "National Safe Boating Week"; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 7 boaters to increase their knowledge of boating and to acquire
- 8 the skills necessary to "boat smart" at all times.
