A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Township of Lower Merion on the occasion of its
2 100th anniversary.

3 WHEREAS, In 1900 the Township of Lower Merion became a First
4 Class Township; and

5 WHEREAS, On March 5, 1900, the first board of commissioners
6 met and organized at the General Wayne Hotel; and

7 WHEREAS, The year 2000 marks the 100th anniversary of Lower
8 Merion Township becoming a First Class Township; and

9 WHEREAS, Lower Merion Township is celebrating its 100th
10 anniversary with various activities and events, with a grand
11 finale on Memorial Day; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
13 Township of Lower Merion and its residents on its 100th
14 anniversary as a First Class Township and encourage all
15 Pennsylvanians to join in this historic celebration.
