- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for the identification of lessees of
- 3 motor vehicles.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1305(c) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes, amended December 21, 1998 (P.L.
- 8 No.151), is amended to read:
- 9 § 1305. Application for registration.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (c) Designation of lessee as registrant.--The owner as
- 12 lessor may designate the lessee as the registrant of the vehicle
- 13 and the name and address of the lessee may be substituted on the
- 14 registration card for the address of the lessor. However, even
- 15 if the lessor does not designate the lessee as the registrant of
- 16 the vehicle, the lessor shall still provide the department with
- 17 the name and address of the lessee. The department shall
- 18 designate the relationship upon the card in a manner it deems

- 1 appropriate. If no designation has been made, the department
- 2 may, by use of a form promulgated by the department, require the
- 3 owner as lessor to identify a lessee for purposes of civil or
- 4 <u>criminal investigation</u>. An owner as lessor who fails to identify
- 5 <u>a lessee commits a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall,</u>
- 6 upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than
- 7 \$1,000 or to imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.
- 8 This subsection is applicable only for the period during which
- 9 the lease remains in effect.

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
