- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for mandatory counseling in
- 3 certain divorce cases.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3302 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 3302. Counseling.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (g) Counseling of minor children.--The court may not grant a
- 11 decree in divorce if the parties have any children between six
- 12 and 16 years of age unless the parties can prove to the court
- 13 that all of those children have attended at least three
- 14 counseling sessions conducted by qualified professionals between
- 15 the time of separation and the granting of the decree.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
