AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Trustees of the University of
2 Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be
6 necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the
7 University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 1999, to
8 June 30, 2000, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:

9	(1) For dental clinics.....	\$938,000	
10	(2) For instruction in the Doctor of Medicine		
11	program.....	4,034,000	
12	(3) For veterinary activities.....	32,276,000	
13	(4) FOR CARDIOVASCULAR STUDIES.....	500,000	<—
14	(5) FOR THE CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OF		
15	PENNSYLVANIA.....	500,000	

16 Section 2. Payments to the University of Pennsylvania on

1 account of the appropriations for the items provided in section
2 1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the
3 basis of costs during the fiscal year and shall be conditioned
4 on continuing authority for inclusion on the Board of Trustees
5 of the University of Pennsylvania of a minimum of ~~five~~ FOUR <—
6 persons who are not elected officials and who are appointed by
7 ~~the Governor~~, the President pro tempore of the Senate, the <—
8 Minority Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of
9 Representatives and the Minority Leader of the House of
10 Representatives for terms of office coterminous with that of the
11 respective appointing authority.

12 Section 3. The University of Pennsylvania shall provide
13 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by
14 the Department of Education or the chairman or the minority
15 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the
16 chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations
17 Committee of the House of Representatives.

18 Section 4. The University of Pennsylvania shall report its
19 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements
20 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and
21 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the
22 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth
23 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of
24 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-
25 Related Colleges and Universities."

26 Section 5. The Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania
27 shall report on forms provided by the Department of Education to
28 both the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations
29 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman
30 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives

1 by September 30, 2000, on how State-appropriated funds were
2 expended for fiscal year 1999-2000 to reduce the costs to
3 Pennsylvania resident students or to provide services to
4 Pennsylvania residents.

5 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1999, or
6 immediately, whichever is later.
