AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for compulsory school age.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 1326 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 Section 1326. Definitions.--The term "compulsory school
- 13 age, " as hereinafter used, shall mean the period of a child's
- 14 life from the time the child's parents elect to have the child
- 15 enter school, which shall be not later than at the age of eight
- 16 (8) years, until the age of [seventeen (17)] eighteen (18)
- 17 years. The term shall not include any child who holds a
- 18 certificate of graduation from a regularly accredited senior
- 19 high school.

- 1 The term "migratory child," wherever used in this subdivision
- 2 of this article, shall include any child domiciled temporarily
- 3 in any school district for the purpose of seasonal employment,
- 4 but not acquiring residence therein, and any child accompanying
- 5 his parent or guardian who is so domiciled.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
