- 22 (1) The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to
- 23 persons who satisfy all of the following:
- 24 (i) Are residents of this Commonwealth.
- 25 (ii) Are on active and full-time duty in the United
- 26 <u>States Armed Forces.</u>
- 27 (iii) Are assigned to a facility outside this
- 28 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- (iv) Are on temporary leave in this Commonwealth.

- (D.1) RULES AND REGULATIONS. -- THE COMMISSION MAY PROMULGATE 10

- 12 AND TRANSFER OF BOAT REGISTRATIONS BY ISSUING AGENTS AS IT DEEMS
