## AN ACT

Declaring and adopting the poem "Independence," by James C. 2 Kanelos, as the State poem of the Commonwealth of 3 Pennsylvania. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Official State poem. 7 The poem "Independence," by James C. Kanelos, is hereby 8 adopted as the State poem of Pennsylvania and shall be the 9 official poem for all public purposes upon satisfaction of the 10 requirements of section 2. The lyrics of the poem are as 11 follows: 12 INDEPENDENCE 13 "In Seventeen Hundred and Seventy Six, The Declaration was affixed, 14 15 Each member signed with Feathered Quill, 16 To bring us all, Peace and Good-will. 17 It has been said, to all accord,

"The Pen is mightier than the Sword,"

- 1 Our Independence We Have Won,
- Now a New Nation has begun. . .
- With passing years, so Strong and Free,
- 4 Americans, We're Proud to be,
- 5 Around the World, let it be told,
- The Precious Freedom, That we hold.
- 7 Let us not Forget, the Many Brave,
- Whose efforts made, 'OLD GLORY' wave.
- 9 United we Stand, Divided we fall,
- 10 Independence we'll cherish, For One
- 11 and For All."
- 12 Section 2. Assignment of copyright.
- 13 (a) Duty of Governor. -- The Governor, on behalf of the
- 14 Commonwealth, shall obtain from the owner of the copyright of
- 15 the poem an assignment of all right, title and interest in the
- 16 copyright to the poem to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and
- 17 shall publish the date of the assignment as a notice in the
- 18 Pennsylvania Bulletin. The date of that publication shall be the
- 19 date of adoption of the official poem.
- 20 (b) Consideration prohibited. -- No payment or other
- 21 consideration shall be paid anyone whosoever for the assignment
- 22 of the poem.
- 23 (c) Reproduction without charge. -- After the assignment is
- 24 obtained by the Governor, the Commonwealth shall not charge
- 25 anyone for reproduction of the official poem.
- 26 Section 3. Effective date.
- 27 This act shall take effect immediately.
