## AN ACT

1 2	Making appropriations to the Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania.	
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
4	hereby enacts as follows:	
5	Section 1. (a) The following sums, or as much thereof as	
б	may be necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the	
7	University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 2000, to	
8	June 30, 2001, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:	
9	(1) For dental clinics \$938,000	
10	(2) For instruction in the Doctor of Medicine	
11	program	
12	(3) For veterinary activities	<
13	(4) For cardiovascular studies 632,000	
14	(3) FOR VETERINARY ACTIVITIES	<
15	(4) FOR CARDIOVASCULAR STUDIES	
16	(b) The sum of <del>\$219,000</del> \$241,000 is hereby appropriated to	<

the Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal 1 year July 1, 2000, to June 30, 2001, for the general maintenance 2 3 of the University of Pennsylvania Museum and the purchase of 4 such apparatus and equipment as the trustees may deem necessary 5 for the best interest of the University of Pennsylvania Museum. 6 Section 2. (a) Payments to the University of Pennsylvania 7 on account of the appropriations for the items provided in section 1(a) shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of 8 Education on the basis of costs during the fiscal year and shall 9 10 be conditioned on continuing authority for inclusion on the 11 Board of Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania of a minimum of four persons who are not elected officials and who are 12 13 appointed by the President pro tempore of the Senate, the 14 Minority Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of 15 Representatives and the Minority Leader of the House of 16 Representatives for terms of office coterminous with that of the 17 respective appointing authority; AND SHALL BE FURTHER 18 CONDITIONED ON THESE APPOINTEES RECEIVING FULL VOTING RIGHTS AS MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES. 19

(b) The University of Pennsylvania shall provide full, complete and accurate information as may be required by the Department of Education or the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives. <-----

(c) The University of Pennsylvania shall report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth 20000S1365B1948 - 2 - of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of
Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State Related Colleges and Universities."

4 (d) The Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania shall 5 report on forms provided by the Department of Education to both the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations 6 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman 7 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives 8 by September 30, 2001, on how State-appropriated funds were 9 expended for fiscal year 2000-2001 to reduce the costs to 10 11 Pennsylvania resident students or to provide services to 12 Pennsylvania residents.

Section 3. (a) Payments to the University of Pennsylvania Museum on account of the appropriation provided in section 1(b) shall be made quarterly by the Executive Director of the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.

17 The Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania shall (b) 18 provide full, complete and accurate information as may be 19 required by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission or 20 the chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations 21 Committee of the Senate or the chairman or the minority chairman 22 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives. 23 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2000, or immediately, whichever is later. 24
