Declaring the week of January 30 through February 5, 2000, as 1 2 "Catholic Schools Week" in this Commonwealth. 3 WHEREAS, Catholic schools in this Commonwealth are celebrating "Catholic Schools Week" from January 30 through 4 February 5, 2000; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Catholic elementary and secondary schools, educating 7 approximately 240,000 students annually, save State and local 8 taxpayers more than 1.3 billion dollars each year; and 9 WHEREAS, Catholic schools instill in young people a strong foundation of values, self-esteem, self-confidence and 10 leadership skills; and 11 WHEREAS, Catholic schools, in providing young people with 12 13 solid values and academic skills needed in becoming responsible citizens of this Commonwealth and nation, have a dropout rate of 14 15 less than 3% and a postgraduate higher education enrollment rate of 80%; therefore be it 16
