REFERRED TO ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AND ENERGY, JUNE 2, 2000

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 Disapproving Environmental Quality Board regulation on Stream
2 Redesignation (Trout Run, Westmoreland County).

3 WHEREAS, The Environmental Quality Board has proposed, at 28
4 Pa.B. 1635 (April 4, 1998), a regulation on Stream
5 Redesignation (Trout Run, Westmoreland County) under the
6 authority of sections 5(b)(1) and 402 of the act of June 22,
7 1937 (P.L.1987, No.394), known as The Clean Streams Law, and
8 section 1920-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175),
9 known as The Administrative Code of 1929; and

10 WHEREAS, The Senate Committee on Environmental Resources and
11 Energy received a report from the Environmental Quality Board
12 under section 7(b) of the act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633,
13 No.181), known as the Regulatory Review Act, that the
14 Independent Regulatory Review Commission disapproved the
15 regulation and that the Environmental Quality Board desires to
16 implement the regulation without revision or modification; and

17 WHEREAS, The committee has determined that the regulation
18 should be disapproved by the General Assembly and notified the

1 Environmental Quality Board of this determination; and

2 WHEREAS, The committee reports this resolution under section
3 7(d) of the Regulatory Review Act for action by the General
4 Assembly within 30 calendar days or ten legislative days,
5 whichever is longer, from the date of reporting this resolution;
6 therefore be it

7 RESOLVED (the House of Representatives concurring), That the
8 General Assembly disapprove the regulation, published at 28
9 Pa.B. 1635 (April 4, 1998), of the Environmental Quality Board
10 on Stream Redesignation (Trout Run, Westmoreland County); and be
11 it further

12 RESOLVED, That notice of the final disposition of this
13 resolution be sent to the Environmental Quality Board and
14 published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
