AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 5, 1913 (P.L.419, No.276) entitled "An
2 act to authorize the display of the State, county, city,
3 borough, or other municipal flags on public buildings in the
4 Commonwealth," providing for display of the Pennsylvania flag
5 for certain deceased persons.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The act of June 5, 1913 (P.L.419, No.276),
9 entitled "An act to authorize the display of the State, county,
10 city, borough, or other municipal flags on public buildings in
11 the Commonwealth," is amended by adding a section to read:

12 Section 3. It shall be lawful to display the flag of
13 Pennsylvania over a memorial, a casket and at a funeral
14 procession of a deceased emergency service responder, member of
15 the General Assembly, former member of the General Assembly,
16 State employee or former State employee. The term "emergency
17 service responder" means an individual who is a member or

1 employe of a volunteer or municipal police department, fire
2 department, ambulance service or rescue squad or a fire police
3 organization.

4 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
